- We hope that all families (Preschool-8th Grade) will be able to join us for a St. Francis de Sales Family outing on September 30. **employee coverage on that evening.** Tickets are \$15/person and only those participating in activities will need to purchase tickets. Those who would just like to attend for fellowship and fun atmosphere will not need to purchase a ticket. Also, we would like to encourage all families to wear their SFdS PRIDE gear when they attend the event!

- **We are in EXTREME NEED of additional car rider volunteers.** Morning volunteers are needed from 7:55am-8:30am and afternoon volunteers are needed from 2:55pm-3:40pm. We currently only have 6 volunteers serving our Parish School in this capacity and are in need of at least 20. Your child(ren) are permitted to wait in their classroom or the office while you are volunteering. We will be inviting our Traffic Engineer to come back to our school in the upcoming week to discuss a better plan for the car rider line to ensure that it is safe, efficient, and does not block traffic of our neighbors. I thank you very much in advance for helping us to fulfill this very important role.
  - **Please note that there is a change to our car rider procedure and all parents/guardians will need to buckle in their child(ren) to their car seats.**
  - Please refrain from talking to the car rider volunteers while you are in line. It is important that they keep their focus on students and cars. This will also help to keep the line moving at a steady pace.
- Please consider adding SCRIP card purchases to your routine! There is a pink flyer that came home in today's Thursday folder with many details on purchasing SCRIP. It is a great and easy way to help out the school and fulfill all of your shopping needs!
- As a reminder, **we will not have school on Friday, October 12 or October 15** so that teachers are able to participate in a Diocesan wide Professional Development. The online calendar, housed on the homepage of the website, has been updated so you may save/print the most recent copy.
