There is an exciting opportunity for any incoming Preschool or Pre-K students! For the 2019-2020 school year, Preschool students will have the opportunity to attend a half day, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30a-11:30a OR a full day on Tuesdays and Thursdays 8:30a-3:00p.

We will continue to offer the Monday-Wednesday-Friday half day or full day Pre-K classes, but we are looking to expand to meet the needs of our community by offering a 5 day/half or full day experience for Pre-K.
